

Department of Oral Medicine & Radiology

About the department

The department is consisting of two sub department in itself: Oral medicine and Oral radiology. This department serves as a connecting link between dentistry and Medicine. The associated clinic is spacious, with adequate automatic dental chairs and well controlled standardized sterilization room. All the patients are thoroughly examined and appropriately diagnosed. The department is concerned with Diagnosis of Oro-facial diseases, including TMJ, Application of Radiation energy and Radio-diagnosis, Management of Medically compromised patients, Medical management of Oral diseases, Treatment of TMJ disorders, and Pain management in Oro-facial regions. There is a separate tobacco cessation clinic, where patients are guided and counselled regarding tobacco cessation.

The department of Oral Radiology is next to Oral Medicine. It consists of intraoral and extraoral radiography room and a dark room. There are three intra oral x-ray machines and one Advanced Digital Panoramic Machine. Students are trained to take Intraoral radiographs and OPG independently.

Academics

The undergraduate curriculum has been designed as per the guidelines of Dental Council of India. The subject is taught in pre-final and final year. The aim is to impart the knowledge and ability in the student to diagnose wide-ranging dental diseases, their diagnosis and treatment planning. There are many national and international publications to the credit of the faculty present in the Dept of Oral Medicine and Radiology.
